## SUBJECT: HRM Quality Management Plan (QMP) – Permanent Reinstatement April 27, 2020

Attention Contractors,

Please note that permanent reinstatement will be permitted on HRM projects (e.g., streets, sidewalks, curbs) beginning Monday April 27, 2020. However, given the current temperature trend, the HRM Quality Management Plan for cold weather will remain in effect until further notice.

Given the current daily high temperatures and the understanding that temperatures should continuously improve, HRM will not require that the QMP Portland cement concrete mixture ("Winter Mix") or silane sealer be utilized at this time. However, in accordance with the specification, immediately after placing, consolidation and strike off, the concrete shall be covered. Please refer to the Supplementary Specifications for complete requirements.

HRM will continue to monitor the weather forecast and will provide an update once temperatures improve.
