Shape the Future of the Refrigeration and A/C Mechanic Trade

The NSAA Board is inviting applications for **one employer and one employee member** to represent Nova Scotia on the Atlantic Trade Advisory Committee for the Refrigeration and A/C Mechanic Trade.

Under the authority of the Atlantic Apprenticeship Council, an Atlantic Trade Advisory Committee will provide input and recommendations towards the development of harmonized apprenticeship and trade certification programs including curriculum standards, examinations, and logbooks.

Eligibility

- Must possess a certificate of qualification in the Refrigeration and A/C Mechanic trade
- Must have a direct and current connection to the trade and Nova Scotia
- Must be a subject matter expert in the trade
- May be required to meet virtually or in-person. Some travel may be involved
- Each trade will have a variety of meetings between June, 2020 and June, 2022
- Women, Aboriginal People, African Nova Scotians, other Racially Visible Persons, Persons with Disabilities and other underrepresented individuals are encouraged to apply.*

*All applicants must possess a certificate of qualification in the Refrigeration and A/C Mechanic trade.
