HRM's Permitting, Planning, Licensing & Compliance System

This memo serves as notice of an upcoming planned outage of the PPL&C system for online permit applications and inspection requests from 8:00 p.m. on Thursday, March 17 until 6:00 a.m. on Monday, March 21, 2022. During this time, both the internal Staff Portal and the online Customer Portal will be unavailable to our customers and staff. The system will be offline; no new applications will be accepted and activity on submitted applications will be limited.

This outage is to support the next release of the PPL&C system: Licensing and Compliance. This release will bring licensing services online for customers and violation inspection and enforcement tracking into the new system for staff. Now, in addition to applying for building and construction permits, businesses and individuals will be able to apply for taxi, temporary sign, sidewalk café and vendor licenses online 24/7.

We appreciate your patience as we add services and enhance our online system to make the service better for everyone. We will communicate through our website and social channels when the online Customer Portal opens on Monday, March 21, 2022.
