

## Scoring

Scorecards must be submitted to golf course staff **immediately following play** to be eligible for scoring. Teams compete for the lowest total team score over 18 holes.

## Method of Play

- Each group names a team captain and a designated scorekeeper before tee-off.
- All players tee off on each hole. With input from the group, the team captain selects the best drive. All players then play their next shot from that location. This process continues until the ball is holed.
- A maximum of three minutes is permitted to search for a lost ball.
- Players are limited to two putts per hole.
- Double-par is the maximum score allowed; once reached, pick up and proceed to the next hole.
- Scores are recorded at the completion of each hole.

## Other Rules

- Balls must be placed within one club length of the selected shot, without improving the lie.
- On the putting green, balls must be placed within three inches of the original position.
- If the selected shot is in a hazard or rough, all players must play from the same condition.
- On the green, each player must attempt the first putt. Do not tap in a missed putt; the first ball holed counts.
- Threesomes may rotate one extra shot or putt to compensate for the fourth player.
- Each team member must contribute a minimum of three drives during the round.

## Prizing

The top three teams at each course will be recognized, followed by the top four teams overall.
