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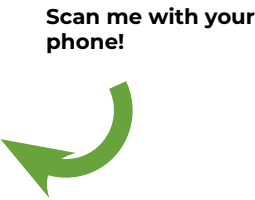

GOLD SEAL CERTIFICATION EXAM

The Gold Seal exam is offered four times annually—typically in March, June, September, and November. Refer to the QR code below for current exam dates and application deadlines.



GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible to write the Gold Seal exam, candidates must meet the following education and experience requirements:

CREDITS:

- Most designations require 100 credits
- Foreperson designation requires 75 credits

EXPERIENCE:

- Minimum five years (50 credits) of experience in your designated role (e.g., project manager required for PM certification)
 - Up to two years of qualifying assistant experience may be applied
- Must currently be employed in the designation being pursued
- Minimum three years' experience in the Canadian construction industry

EDUCATION:

- Minimum 25 credits in education and training
- Completion of Construction Industry Ethics (3 credits) is required
- Completion of Construction 101 in Canada (4 credits) is required for the foreperson designation
- At least two credits must be in a recognized "special topic" course

REMAINING CREDITS:

- For all designations except foreperson, the remaining 25 credits may be earned through additional experience **OR** further education and training

Overview:

Construction 101 in Canada provides a comprehensive introduction to the industrial, commercial, institutional, and civil (ICI+C) construction industry. This course explores how construction projects are planned, delivered, and managed from concept through completion. Participants gain practical insight into project teams, delivery methods, procurement, contracts, regulations, and project close-out, enabling them to contribute more effectively to project success.

Overview:

This foundational course explains the construction processes, how to recognize legal considerations and apply basic risk management principles. The program provides a comprehensive understanding of construction documentation and contract administration concepts, and how they support successful project delivery.

Note: This course is required for anyone pursuing Construction Specifications Canada (CSC) designations. Completion may also contribute toward the experience requirement for the RSW designation.

An Owner’s Guide to Construction Procurement

This introductory course series is designed for general contractors, subcontractors, owners, procurement professionals and consultants involved in competitively procured construction projects. While focused on the Design-Bid-Build delivery model using stipulated price contracts, the content is applicable to a range of project delivery and pricing approaches.

Using the CCA 1 (2021) Standard Stipulated Price Subcontract as a reference, the session highlights important parts of the contractor-subcontractor relationship and common clauses found in subcontracts.

Participants will learn to recognize the importance of meeting minutes as formal project records and understand their role in project communication, risk management, contract administration, and dispute prevention.

Overview:

Lean Construction focuses on reducing costs and increasing value by improving how construction projects are managed. This updated AGC Edge Lean Construction program introduces participants to core lean principles and demonstrates how they can be applied to construction projects through practical, hands-on learning.

Key exercises include the Parade of Trades, which illustrates the impact of workflow reliability on project success, and a simulation of the Last Planner® System, which reinforces predictable planning and continuous improvement.

Completion of all program units makes participants eligible to pursue the exam for the Certificate of Management – Lean Construction (CM-Lean).
